The Yavapai County Board of Supervisors is pleased to announce the continuation of a three-month free slash drop-off program at all county transfer stations beginning March 1, and continuing until June 1, 2010. County transfer stations are located in Bagdad, Black Canyon City, Camp Verde, Congress, Mayer, Seligman, and Skull Valley. Free slash drop off will be held during normal operating hours.

This free slash drop-off program will assist residents in developing necessary defensible space around their homes and other structures that could fuel fires. It is important for citizens to maintain defensible space around their property. Keeping fuels down is absolutely necessary to help avoid uncontrolled fires that can and do become extremely damaging. Please take advantage of the free slash drop off program and clean up around your properties.
