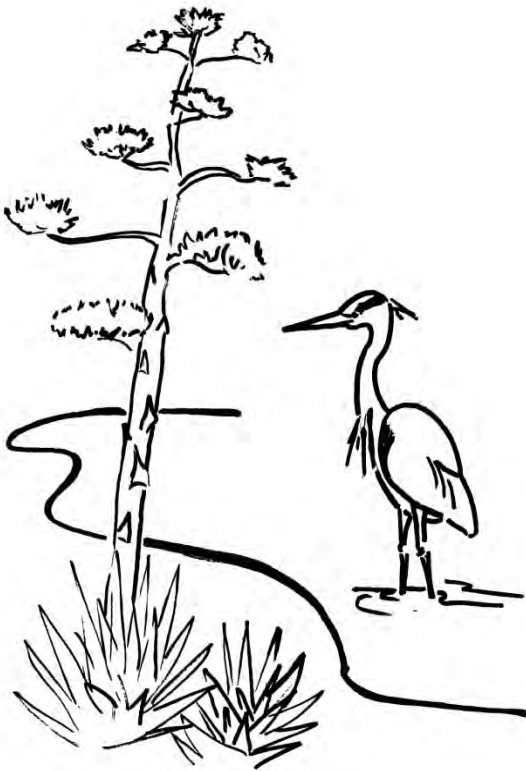
Discover how ancient technologies allowed people to survive and thrive in the Southwest and how **YOU** can help protect the artifacts essential to understanding the past.
